

Moving On curriculum links

Moving On has been written primarily for 14-16 year-olds but will be highly relevant for students aged 16-19 who are preparing to enter the world of work. The 'harder' differentiation options can add challenge for these students. Links for 11-14 are also included for teachers who may choose to use Moving On with younger students, for example to help them choose the right examination courses for their career interests. The 'easier' differentiation options may be helpful for these students.
